

Conyers Middle School Walker's Permission Slip



Dear Parents:

Consistently, we have several students who wish to occasionally walk home after school. While this is not our transportation of choice for our students, we do understand that there are certain times that this may be necessary. Our concern is that your child arrives home safely every day. Our parking lot and Sigman Road becomes a frenzy of activity in the afternoon. Your student will need to understand that walking home requires a wealth of responsibility on behalf of the student and there are guidelines and procedures that the school requires to ensure their safety when leaving campus. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the student's mode of transportation being changed.

All walking students will be dismissed with car riders to leave campus.

- All students who are approved walkers will need to leave campus, at the appointed time, upon exiting their last period classroom. Any student that is remains in the building after release will be subject to a disciplinary consequence.
- Students walking home will need to exit through door 1. If the student needs to cross Sigman Road, he/she will proceed down the walk way heading towards the red light. Students should not cross the street at any point other than the cross walk.
- After school/ extracurricular activities that require the students to leave campus and then return at a later time
 (sporting events, plays, dances, etc.) to participate, the student must walk home and then return at the start of
 the event. They cannot remain on campus to await the start of the extracurricular event. If the student
 violates this requirement, a parent will be called to pick up their child and the student will not be allowed to
 participate in the activity.
- Local businesses have requested that students be advised that they should not hang out at the businesses around campus. Once authorized students leave our campus at their authorized time, the responsibility for their behavior does not rest with the school.
- The administrative team reserves the right to not allow students to walk home on any given day due to inclement weather or any other unforeseen events that they feel could negatively affect the student's safety.
- All transportation changes must be submitted in writing and verified by our office/administrative staff prior to be approved.

Please read the above information with your child as applicable. This form must be signed by you *and* your child (ren) before the student(s) is permitted to walk home.
