	What you CAN wear @ school	What you CAN'T wear @ school
Head	Solid colored, <u>folded</u> scarves to hold ponytails/hair in place	Hats, rollers, visors, caps, do rags, bandannas, scarves with print
Shoulders	Shirts, blouses, t-shirts with collars that cover shoulders	Spaghetti straps, tank tops, jerseys without t-shirt and cutoff sleeveless shirts; anything "see-through" or low-cut
Waist	Pants & skirts at natural waist with undergarments not visible; shirts tucked in; hoodies/jackets in lockers	Pants, skirts, shorts below waist; visible undergarments; extremely baggy pants, spandex, pajamas or pajama pants
Knees	Shorts, skirts and dresses must be that are knee length; jeans/pants with holes permissible with <b>NO</b> visible skin above knee	Shirts, skirts that are above the knee; Pajamas; jeans/pants with holes that show skin above knee
Toes	Shoes that are properly fastened (for students' safety reasons)	House slippers, slide-ons, flip-flops, shower shoes, etc.
